What is Roll Ball?

Roll Ball is a game played between two teams. Roll Ball is played on "Roller Shoes". Each team consists of 12 (Twelve) players, 6 (Six) on the field and 6 (Six) in reserve. The main objective of the game is to score maximum goals within a stipulated time. The main feature of Roll Ball is that the ball is held in single or both the hands, even when passing on to the other players, and is repeatedly bounced on the ground.

Here's an overview of how Roll Ball is played:

Equipment: Players wear roller or inline skates and protective gear such as helmets, knee pads, elbow pads, wrist guards and other necessary equipments. The game is played with a ball which is specially designed and manufactured for this game.

Objective: The primary objective of Roll Ball is to score goals by throwing the ball into the opponent's goalpost. Each goal scored adds points to the scoring team.

Playing Field: The playing area is 40 meters X 20 meters with boundary lines marking the court's perimeter. There are two goalposts at each end of the court, penalty line drawn before the D area.

Gameplay: Players use their hands to dribble, pass, and shoot the ball while skating on the court. They can also block opponents and try to regain possession of the ball. The game involves a combination of balance, speed, agility, and teamwork.

Rules: The rules of Roll Ball are specifically drafted considering the game thrill and skills, with some unique variations. For example, players must pass or dribble the ball while skating, and physical contact between players is limited to certain situations.

Scoring: Points are awarded when a player successfully shoots the ball into the opponent's goalpost. The team with the highest score at the end of the game wins.
